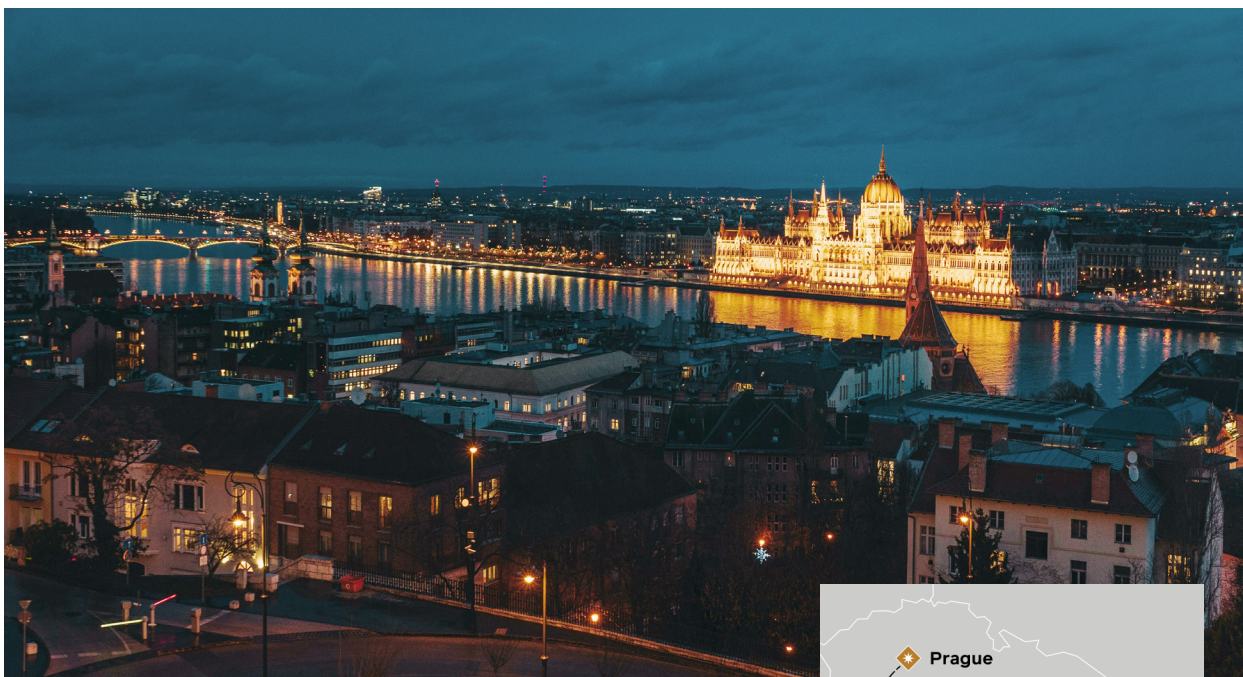

DAYS 01-02: AUGUSTINE HOTEL

A Luxury Collection hotel, The Augustine is tucked between Prague Castle and the Charles Bridge. Still home to a functioning monastery, it blends Gothic history with clean, contemporary design, cloistered courtyards, and a spa that feels worlds away from the city's bustle. Its bar still serves St. Thomas beer, brewed to the monks' original recipe.

DAY 01

MONASTERY WELCOME

Arrive in Prague and transfer to The Augustine. This evening, begin your journey with a warm welcome among vaulted halls and quiet courtyards. A tour for a short look into the hotel's storied past sets the tone, followed by a convivial dinner with your fellow travelers.

DAY 02

CASTLE TO OLD TOWN

Prague is a city best uncovered on foot, where Gothic towers and baroque domes frame lively squares. A guided walk reveals the city's story, from castle heights through gardens and across the Charles Bridge into Old Town.

- ♦ **YOUR CHOICE:** Spend the afternoon and evening as you wish – lunching at a café, discovering galleries, or simply letting the city's rhythm guide you.
- ♦ **MEALS:** Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

DAYS 03-06: MS SAVOR

Purpose-built for river cruising, *ms Savor* carries fewer guests than most ships of its size, creating an airy, intimate feel. On your seven-night cruise, you'll share the riverboat with Tauck guests traveling on a different itinerary, but your Roam by Tauck group of just 20 travels its own path – with a dedicated Roam Director and exclusive daily schedule. More than a ship, *ms Savor* becomes your floating community: evenings bring social hours in the Panorama Lounge, live local music, and flexible dining that matches the pace of your days ashore. The sun deck becomes a favorite spot for quiet moments between capitals, while your stateroom remains a restful retreat.

DAY 03

FAIRYTALE DETOUR

Depart Prague with a stop in Český Krumlov, where winding lanes and a riverside castle feel lifted from another century. By late afternoon, board your Tauck riverboat. Dinner onboard introduces the relaxed rhythm of river life.

- ♦ **YOUR CHOICE:** Join your Roam Director for an optional pub stroll in Passau.
- ♦ **MEALS:** Breakfast, Dinner

DAY 04

PASSAU & ENGELHARTSZELL

Begin your morning in Passau, where three rivers converge beneath pastel façades and baroque domes. A guided walk reveals the Old Town's character, before crossing into Austria for a visit to a local home where you'll learn about the family's everyday life.

- ♦ **YOUR CHOICE:** You may choose to cycle the riverside path from Passau to Engelhartzell, "racing" the ship on a flat, scenic route through small towns and countryside.
- ♦ **MEALS:** Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner



DAY 05

GREIN & WACHAU

The Wachau Valley opens with timeless small towns, vines, and river views. Begin the day with a locally guided hike through the forests near Grein. In the evening, a tavern visit introduces Austria's Heuriger tradition – wine, conversation, and music flowing easily together.

- ♦ **YOUR CHOICE:** Instead of the hike, spend free time visiting Grein Castle on your own.
- ♦ **MEALS:** Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

DAY 06

DÜRNSTEIN & WACHAU

The blue abbey tower of Dürnstein rises above vineyards and orchards – an iconic gateway to the Wachau. This is a day to feel the valley's pace, whether pedaling paths or enjoying the view from the deck. By evening, Vienna comes into sight.

- ♦ **YOUR CHOICE:** Ride through the Wachau Valley on a guided or self-paced cycling excursion – mostly flat paths tracing the river through villages and vines.
- ♦ **MEALS:** Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

DAYS 07-10: MS SAVOR

DAY 07

VIENNA

Begin the day on two wheels, joining a local guide for a city spin that opens Vienna from a new angle. Pedal along the Ring Boulevard past the Opera and Parliament, through leafy Prater Park, and into the Museum Quarter – an easy, inspiring ride through the city's grand and creative sides. The morning ends at the Leopold Museum, where secessionist art reveals Vienna's modern soul. Later, step into the elegance of Palais Pallavicini for a private Elmayer waltz lesson – an evening steeped in Viennese tradition.

- ♦ **YOUR CHOICE:** Enjoy the early afternoon and evening at leisure. Vienna rewards exploration, whether in cafés, galleries, or concert halls.
- ♦ **MEALS:** Breakfast, Lunch



DAY 08

BRATISLAVA

Slovakia's capital mixes pastel façades and cobblestoned charm with a playful, modern spirit. After time in the Old Town, return to the ship for a relaxed evening with live local entertainment.

- ♦ **YOUR CHOICE:** Suit up for rafting at Čunovo, guided through splashy Class II-III rapids, or visit the Danubiana Art Museum on the riverbank. Afterwards, spend the afternoon entirely at your own pace in Bratislava's pedestrian center – cafés, galleries, and shop-lined streets all within easy reach.
- ♦ **MEALS:** Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

DAY 09

BUDAPEST

During a locally guided morning tour, Budapest greets you with grandeur on both banks of the Danube – castle heights in Buda, broad boulevards in Pest. A cooking class adds flavor to the day, with traditional dishes shared for lunch. Tonight, raise a farewell toast as the city lights shimmer across the river.

- ♦ **YOUR CHOICE:** Walk or take a coach to Fisherman's Bastion for the start of the tour. The afternoon is free to follow your own path in the city.
- ♦ **MEALS:** Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

DAY 10

JOURNEY ON

Enjoy breakfast onboard before departing. Transfers are included to Budapest Ferenc Liszt International Airport (BUD), with the option to extend your stay in Budapest.

- ♦ **YOUR CHOICE:** Depart in the morning with included transfers, or linger longer with a post-stay in Budapest – an elegant extension that keeps the Danube close a little while more.
- ♦ **MEALS:** Breakfast



TRIP PREP & ESSENTIALS

WHAT'S INCLUDED ON THIS JOURNEY?

All hotel and riverboat accommodations, excursions, meals and beverages aboard the ship (including unlimited wine, beer, spirits, and soft drinks), select meals on shore, sightseeing, port charges, gratuities, and the services of ship staff, local guides, your Roam Directors and your Roam Cruise Director are included.

WHAT'S NOT INCLUDED?

International round trip airfare, travel protection plans, laundry and spa services aboard the riverboat, and any activities and meals you choose to pursue during free time that are not outlined in the itinerary are not included in the price of the trip.

WHERE DOES THE TRIP START AND END?

The journey begins in Prague, with included transfers to the hotel from Václav Havel Airport Prague (PRG) or Prague Hlavní Nádraží Train Station, provided we receive your arrival details at least three weeks in advance. The journey ends in Budapest, with included transfers to Budapest Ferenc Liszt International Airport (BUD) or Budapest train stations. Transfers may be shared with fellow Roam by Tauck guests.

HOW ACTIVE IS THIS JOURNEY?

The activity level of this tour is 4 and is designed for fit, vigorous travelers capable of easily walking 3+ miles over hills and and/or rocky or uneven terrain. Many days might include active pursuits such as hiking, bicycling or kayaking one to three hours at a time.

WHAT TRAVEL DOCUMENTS ARE NEEDED?

U.S. citizens need a passport valid for six months beyond the end of the trip; no visa required.

The U.S. State Department advises that: "All foreigners seeking entry into the Czech Republic must also carry proof of a medical insurance policy contracted for payment of all costs for hospitalization and medical treatment while in the Czech Republic. According to the Czech Government, if you have a health insurance card or an internationally recognized credit card with health insurance included, it will generally be accepted as proof of insurance to enter the country." Tauck offers travel protection that is considered sufficient for this purpose. Please refer to the Tauck Travel Protection Product section above on this webpage for further details.



Non-U.S. citizens should check with an embassy or consulate of the Czech Republic, Germany, Austria, Slovakia, and Hungary for entry requirements.

ARE THERE ANY ADDITIONAL COSTS FOR SOLO TRAVELERS?

Yes. Solo travelers typically pay an additional cost known as a solo supplement, which covers the second portion of the room rate normally shared between two guests. DEPOSIT AND PAYMENT SCHEDULE

Deposits & Payments: A \$900 per person deposit (plus optional Protection Plan or Cancel Fee Waiver) is due at booking. Final payment is due 90 days before departure for land journeys, and 120 days for cruises and rail. If paid by credit card, final payment will be charged automatically unless you opt out at booking. Unpaid bookings may be canceled and subject to fees.

TAUCK'S CRUISE PROTECTION

Tauck's Cruise and Event Protection gives you added peace of mind, with cancellation coverage before your journey begins and insurance benefits while you're traveling. To be eligible, it must be purchased within 10 days of your initial deposit. This optional protection includes:

Cancel for Any Reason: Under Tauck's Cancellation Fee Waiver you can cancel your tour for ANY REASON and Tauck will reduce the regular cancellation fees outlined herein, provided we are notified of your cancellation before your cruise departs. Certain terms and restrictions apply. (except in Extreme Circumstances*)

Trip Cancellation: Should you cancel for covered reasons, the plan reimburses cancellation fees imposed, up to your total trip cost.

Trip Interruption: If you have to interrupt your tour for covered reasons, the plan provides reimbursement up to \$10,000 to catch up to your tour or return home.

Travel Delay: Provides reimbursement for missed, prepaid travel arrangements if you are delayed by a common carrier, natural disaster, unannounced strike, or other reasons as cited in the plan.

Medical Expense: Reimburses covered medical expenses incurred in the event you become injured or sick during your trip.

Baggage / Personal Effects Protection: Provides reimbursement in the event your luggage or personal effects are lost, stolen, damaged or delayed during your trip.



Worldwide Emergency Assistance Services: Provided by Carefree Travel Assistance; 24-hour emergency telephone assistance hotline for medical and travel related problems.

WHAT IF I NEED TO CANCEL?

If you cancel within 10 days of initial deposit: Within the first 10 days after you place your initial deposit, you may cancel your reservation for any reason with no cancellation fees.

If you cancel more than 10 days after initial deposit: Regardless of reason, cancellations result in costly charges from our travel and hotel providers covering penalties and fees incurred by canceling confirmed bookings. These fees vary from tour to tour. Therefore, the following fees apply for this tour.

Cancellation Fees with Tauck's Cruise Protection Plan:

- ♦ *120 days or more before departure:* Loss of cost of Tauck's Cruise and Event Protection fee per person
- ♦ *119 - 60 days before departure:* Loss of 25% of the cost of the cruise, not including air (if applicable), plus loss of Cruise and Event Protection fee, per person
- ♦ *59 - 1 days before departure:* Loss of 50% of the cost of the cruise, not including air (if applicable), plus loss of Cruise and Event Protection fee, per person

Cancellation Fees without Tauck's Cruise Protection Plan:

- ♦ *120 days or more before departure:* \$900 per person
- ♦ *119 - 60 days before departure:* Loss of 50% of the cost of cruise, not including air (if applicable), per person
- ♦ *59 - 1 days before departure:* Loss of 100% of the cost of cruise, not including air (if applicable), per person

Tour Interruption Fees: If you have to interrupt your tour en route, you may be entitled to a refund for the unused land portion if it exceeds 24 hours; certain restrictions apply. Such refunds are based upon the number of overnight missed less a fee of \$40 per person per day for unused transportation and other fixed expenses.



PRAGUE & THE DANUBE

Partial Room Cancellation: A person who cancels or leaves a tour while a roommate remains constitutes a cancellation of one type of accommodation and rebooking of another type of accommodation. The price charged to the remaining person is the new, higher price for the new accommodation.

In the event of an unforeseen circumstance beyond our control, Tauck reserves the right to amend the cancellation and transfer terms outlined herein.

Note: All Guests, regardless of residency, who book a Tauck journey have the option of purchasing the Cancellation Waiver provided by Tauck in the event they need to cancel their trip after making their reservations. Tauck's Cruise & Event Protection, which includes both the Cancellation Fee Waiver and the Travel Insurance Benefits and Assistance Services described above, is not available to residents of Puerto Rico.
