WHAT'S INCLUDED ON THIS JOURNEY?

WHERE DOES THE TRIP START AND END?

The journey begins in Mexico City, with included transfers to the hotel from Benito Juárez International Airport (MEX), provided we receive your arrival details at least three weeks in advance. The journey ends in San Miguel de Allende, with included transfers to Queretaro Intercontinental Airport (QRO) or Guanajuato International Airport (BJX). Transfers may be shared with fellow Roam by Tauck guests.

HOW ACTIVE IS THIS JOURNEY?

The activity level of this tour is 3 and active components such as hiking, bicycling and walking longer distances may be included. Hills and/or uneven terrain may be encountered on several days. Guests should be able to walk two or three miles and stand for long periods of time with no difficulty.

WHAT TRAVEL DOCUMENTS ARE NEEDED?

U.S. citizens need a passport valid for six months beyond the end of the trip; no visa is required for entry into Mexico. Non-U.S. citizens should check with an embassy or consulate of Mexico to determine what travel documentation are required for entry. All guests are required to provide their passport information to Tauck at time of booking.

Please Note: Longer stays abroad for any purpose may require additional travel documentation.



ARE THERE ANY ADDITIONAL COSTS FOR SOLO TRAVELERS?

Yes. Solo travelers typically pay an additional cost known as a solo supplement, which covers the second portion of the room rate normally shared between two guests. DEPOSIT AND PAYMENT SCHEDULE

Deposits & Payments: A \$700 per person deposit (plus optional Protection Plan or Cancel Fee Waiver) is due at booking. Final payment is due 90 days before departure for land journeys, and 120 days for cruises and rail. If paid by credit card, final payment will be charged automatically unless you opt out at booking. Unpaid bookings may be canceled and subject to fees.

TAUCK'S GUEST PROTECTION

WHAT IF I NEED TO CANCEL?

If you cancel within 10 days of initial deposit: Within the first 10 days after you place your initial deposit, you may cancel your reservation for any reason with no cancellation fees.

If you cancel more than 10 days after initial deposit: Regardless of reason, cancellations result in costly charges from our travel and hotel providers covering penalties and fees incurred by canceling confirmed bookings. These fees vary from tour to tour. Therefore, the following fees apply.
